

## 2015 Iphöfer Julius-Echter-Berg VDP.Erste Lage Riesling dry

The grape variety Riesling, also known as the "king of white wines", grows best on Franconia's sunniest sites. Our top site "Julius-Echter-Berg" offers these perfect conditions: steep hills and south exposed location enabling the grapes to ripen ideally and aromas to develop to perfection - you will taste it.

Our Riesling VDP.Erste Lage features a fine fruit, is intensive and well-balanced in taste. The bouquet of peach and apricot makes this Riesling a noble indulgence. Thanks to its citrus flavours and a well-bounded, exciting acidity, this Riesling shows a fresh and elegant character. The gypsum soil provides this wine with fine tangy and unique mineral notes.

At the world's largest Riesling competition "Best of Riesling 2016", this Riesling achieved 93 points. The jury spoke in high terms not only of its "most animating, fruity aroma" but also its "refreshing finish".

The editors of the Wine Spectator awarded it with 92 points (03/2017, p. 106): "Very fruity, this is redolent of apple pastry, peach tart and custard flavors that feature some smoky notes. Lush and spicy on the finish, with plenty of cream and spice details."
